The opposing problem is that many families that live in the surrounding Nashville-area are barely keeping themselves afloat — our neighbors in low-income areas, disabled or handicapped, and the elderly and aging. It is hard for these people and families to see the “light at the end of the tunnel” because of the constraints within their lives.

Neighborhoods and families have been changed because of Nashville Workcamp. For the last 20 years, Nashville Workcamp has done its best to “shine a light” (Matthew 5:16) to those that need to know that Jesus is alive and well in Nashville. Many homes over the years have gotten a fresh coat of paint, a yard cleanup, or even a kind word from a teenage student, as a result of the dedication of Nashville Workcamp.
